#### Writing **Methodology**

Participants will be guided through a structured writing process that includes:

- Initial Manuscript Preparation: Participants will prepare a draft before the bootcamp.
- Workshop Activities: Hands-on workshops will focus on improving and finalizing manuscripts for submission to high-impact journals.
- Peer Review: Sessions will include peer feedback and expert guidance to refine articles.
- Publication Submission: Finalized manuscripts will be submitted for publication by the end of the bootcamp. UiTM's Publication Manager will provide 20-30 journal slots for submission by June 30, 2025. The submitted papers will be peer-reviewed by the journals

#### Tentative Schedule

<b>Day 1</b> (30 May)	Arrival and check-in, community service, and evening rest.
<b>Day 2</b> (31 May)	Opening remarks, panel discussions, and writing workshops.
<b>Day 3</b> (1 June)	Full-day writing workshops and networking dinner.
Day 4 (2 June)	Final workshops, article submission, and closing ceremony.
<b>Day 5</b> (3 June)	Optional city sightseeing (self-financed) and departure.

- Manuscripts refined during the bootcamp will be submitted for publication in Scopus, WoS, ERA, or MyCite-indexed journals.
