



## STAY FIT WITH JOM SIHAT PROGRAM

A one-day community service programme for the *Orang Asli* communities in Kg. Bukit Tadam, Banting, Selangor was successfully conducted by the **Transformational Accounting Education (TAE) Research Cluster, Faculty of Accountancy, UiTM**. This programme was held in collaboration with the **Department of Orang Asli Development [JAKOA]** and the **Ministry of Defence [MINDEF]** on 8 of October 2022. A total of 15 faculty members and alumni and 200 *Orang Asli* community participated in this event.

The opening speech by the Dean of the Faculty of Accountancy was followed by a speech by the JAKOA representative, the Kuala Langat and Klang District Officer, En Mohd Nor Haji Yaakub. Dr. Kamaruzzaman Muhammad delivered the primary agenda of raising awareness about basic financial management through cooperative establishment.

Throughout the community service programme, additional supporting activities included were the promotion of UiTM's pre-education programme, MINDEF's health and dental screening, and the donation of clothes, new/used books, and basic groceries. The committee also set up a book corner in the village Community Hall for the children of the *Orang Asli* community and distributed lucky draw prizes to them for their participation.

# UiTM-CGMA FINANCE LEADERSHIP PROGRAM (FLP)



The importance of being relevant is key for future graduates entering the workforce. A global qualification nurtures the relevant values and skill sets, which contributes to a fulfilling career. UiTM was appointed as a CIMA FLP Partner, which provides a new guided learning and assessment route to completing CIMA's CGMA Professional Qualification and earning the CGMA designation.

The launching ceremony of UiTM-CGMA Finance Leadership Program (FLP) took place on 23 July 2022, which witnessed the signing of agreement between The Chartered Institute of Management Accountants (CIMA) with UiTM. The ceremony was officiated by Yang Berbahagia Professor Datin Dr. Suzana Sulaiman, Deputy Vice-Chancellor (Academic and International).

In addition, the ceremony presented the certificate of completion to 43 MSMA-CIMA graduates. The Master in Strategic Management Accounting (MSMA) is a dual qualification offered by Faculty of Accountancy, UiTM where students will be awarded a Master's Degree and the CIMA professional qualification (after successful completion of the professional examination).





## STRENGTHENING FACULTY-INDUSTRY ENGAGEMENT WITH COURTESY VISIT

On September 15, 2022, a team of six delegates from the Faculty of Accountancy, UiTM, led by the Dean, Prof. Dr. Haslinda Yusoff, paid their courtesy visit to **Auditor General office**. They were welcomed by the Auditor General of Malaysia, Datuk Seri Nik Azman Abdul Majid. The subsequent visit of the day was made to the **Accountant General office**. Welcoming the Faculty envoys are Datuk Dr. Yacob Mustafa, Accountant General of Malaysia, Tuan Haji Rozaimi Idris.

The purpose of this visit was to discuss potential collaborations and partnerships between the faculty and the two key government agencies of Malaysia. Constructive discussion for research opportunities, staff professional development and joint engagement programmes were mutually agreed. Both parties were also keen to explore the opportunity for offering short courses and industry post graduates' studies for industry professionals.

The dynamic partnership between the faculty and the Accountant General Department began in 2012 with the award of subsequent consultancy contract for the faculty as a tuition provider for professional accounting qualification training. The most recent contract worth RM1.1 million was awarded from January 1, 2021 until December 31, 2023.




