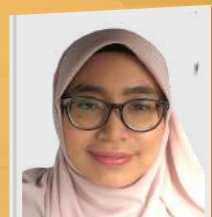

achieved for the faculty to achieve the 6-star rating such as low number of course failure, having more than 10% of students achieved the dean's award and others. These targets certainly require everyone's involvement; the faculty's management, the lecturers, and the students as well.



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EXTERNAL RECOGNITIONS FOR THE INNOVATORS

Creating and encouraging an innovative academic environment has always been one of the main agendas of the Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM). In this vein, our academic members have been actively involved in innovation competitions and exhibitions with a range of remarkable achievements. For example, in 2019, the Faculty of Accountancy bagged the Best Contingent Award in the Invention, Innovation, and Design Exhibition (IIDEX) 2019 with 12 Gold and 8 Silver medallists.

IIDEX is an annual invention and innovation competition organised by the Business Innovation and Technology Commercialisation Centre (BITCOM), UiTM. In IIDEX 2020, the Faculty of Accountancy won the First Runner-up Contingent with 7 Gold and 14 Silver medals.

At the international level, the members of the faculty won 4 Gold medals in the International Technology Exposition (ITEX) 2020.

The followings are the 4 products:

- Iziwizi: Financial Power for Fraud Prevention
- DrRiskCare - Your Risk Management Cure
- Micro Finance Tax Calculator and Accounting System (MIFTACS)
- Digital Accounting Card Challenge (D-ACC)

The innovation excellence was sustained in 2021 with 1 Gold and 2 Silver medals won in the Malaysia Technology Expo (MTE). The Gold medallist team, led by Puan Nor Syafinaz Shaffee with their product, EDUTAX101, was also awarded as the Best Category Award for the Education Technology and Pedagogy category in the MTE 2021.

Furthermore, another project by the faculty members headed by Professor Dr. Erlane K Ghani, marked a history when it won quadruple awards from the International Innovation Arsvot Malaysia (IAM) 2021. The project entitled Leadership Profiling System Management for Higher Institutions won the Gold Award, Best Award, Best Visual Award, and Best of the Best Innovation Award.

The Faculty of Accountancy is expecting more innovation prizes in 2021 with the upcoming IIDEX2021 and ITEX2021 scheduled to take place in October and December respectively.



THE FACULTY'S PROFESSORS INVITED AS GUEST LECTURERS AT THE DURBAN UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY, SOUTH AFRICA

The experts from the Faculty of Accountancy (FACT) are not only recognized locally but also internationally. Recently, two of FACT's professors, Professor Dr. Haslinda Yusoff and Professor Datin Dr. Suzana Sulaiman were invited to deliver virtual lectures to the postgraduate students and academics at the Durban University of Technology (DUT), South Africa. Ever since DUT and the Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM) signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in June 2020, DUT has become one of FACT's active international partners.

In her lecture on 27 May 2021, Professor Dr. Haslinda, the Dean of FACT and also an expert in Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) reporting, talked about how CSR evolved over time and the way forward. These lectures saw robust discussions among the speakers and audience reflecting the relevance of the topics and the speakers' ability to hold the audience captivated. These successful lectures are believed to have helped enhance the image of FACT among its global peers.

In another lecture that took place virtually on 31 May 2021, Professor Datin Suzana, who is the present Assistant Vice Chancellor, Institute of Knowledge and Quality Management (InQKA) and a Management Accounting expert discussed the roles of and challenges facing the management accountants in the face of digitalization and other exogenous business disruptions.



SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY COMMITMENT: ANNUAL FINANCIAL STATEMENTS PREPARATION FOR THE MALAYSIAN ADVOCATES OF CEREBRAL PALSY

Despite its wide range of demanding academic- and research-related commitments, the Faculty of Accountancy (FACT) has never sidelined its social responsibility. One of the entities that has benefited from the FACT's accounting expertise is the Malaysian Advocates of Cerebral Palsy (MyCP).

MyCP is a non-governmental organization (NGO) registered with the Registrar of Society (ROS), established with the aim of providing support for children and adults with cerebral palsy and their families. Cerebral palsy or known as CP is a group of disorders that affect a person's ability to move and maintain balance and posture.

Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM) and MyCP signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in 2017. Commencing in 2020, a group of FACT's academic members assisted MyCP prepared its 2019 financial statements at no charges. These generous lecturers are also members of the Public and Corporate Accounting Reporting (formerly known as Accounting Measurement and Reporting) Research Cluster, who are Associate Professor Dr. Amrizah Kamaluddin, Dr. Radziah Mahmud, Rosmini Mohd Aripin, and Nurshamimi Sabli. This group of academics continued to provide similar assistance in early 2021 and successfully completed the preparation of the MyCP's 2020 financial statements.

Their intervention had helped MyCP produced a set of true and fair financial statements in accordance with the approved accounting standards. This FACT's engagement with MyCP is an excellent example of how a university can leverage its expertise and discharge its social responsibility.

This program is offered for full time mode and part time mode. In May 2021, 9 of the students of this program have passed the Strategic Course Study Course Exam.



RAMADHAN PROGRAM

During Ramadan 2021, Faculty of Accountancy has embarked on special initiative to organise various activities for its communities in line with the spirit of the holy month.

The first project in the month of Ramadan was focusing on activities involving charity and providing aid to the underprivileged faculty communities. Since there were 70 accounting students in both Puncak Alam and Shah Alam campuses who returned to UiTM due to internet accessibility issues and unfavourable study environment at home, the faculty feels obligated to assist them especially during the month of Ramadan. Furthermore, majority of them were from B40 category. Hence, the faculty has initiated a "FACT Ramadhan Iftar and Sahur" activity by providing continuous food assistance to students who residing in college for breaking fast (iftar) and have early morning meal before dawn (sahur). This will also assist in reducing students' financial burden in their daily food expenditure. The activity started from 22nd April 2021 and continued until 12th May 2021.

It was officiated by the Dean of Faculty of Accountancy who had taken her time to attend two of the food giving events iftar and sahur. Since there are 40 students who are residing in colleges and not going back home for Eid Celebration (Hari Raya Aidilfitri), the faculty has decided to extend the food assistance aid beyond 12th June 2021 until 16th June 2021. The faculty also provided special Hari Raya delicacies on 13th May 2021 for the students who celebrate the Eid festival away from their hometown due to the SOPs that being adhered. For "FACT Ramadhan Iftar and Sahur" activity including Hari Raya Aidilfitri, various contributions were received from faculty's current and former staffs, alumni, and non-governmental organisation (NGO).

The faculty also has taken its initiatives by providing learning devices like laptops for B40 students who do not have the right tool to attend virtual classes throughout the Covid-19 pandemic as well during the holy month of Ramadan. For this, the faculty

organised a “FACT 1 Gadget 1 Student 2.0 Campaign” in the early days of Ramadan to get devices contributions from faculty’s staffs and alumni.

As a result, the faculty received 29 laptops contribution to be given to selected eligible students. Laptops received were distributed in a ceremony attended by Rector of UCS and Dean of Faculty of Accountancy on 21st April 2021, held in Faculty of Accountancy Room of Excellence (Bilik Kecemerlangan). The ceremony was held in hybrid mode with 11 students attended physically and 18 virtually. The 11 who attended the event physically received their laptops directly from the Rector of UCS while another 19 received theirs via courier.

B40 students also received Duit Raya token under Faculty Charity Drive which also parts of the contributions that started from 13 April 2021 until 11 May 2021. This event aimed to foster the giving culture and helping those in need among faculty members and students. The top 100 B40 students have benefited from this initiative.

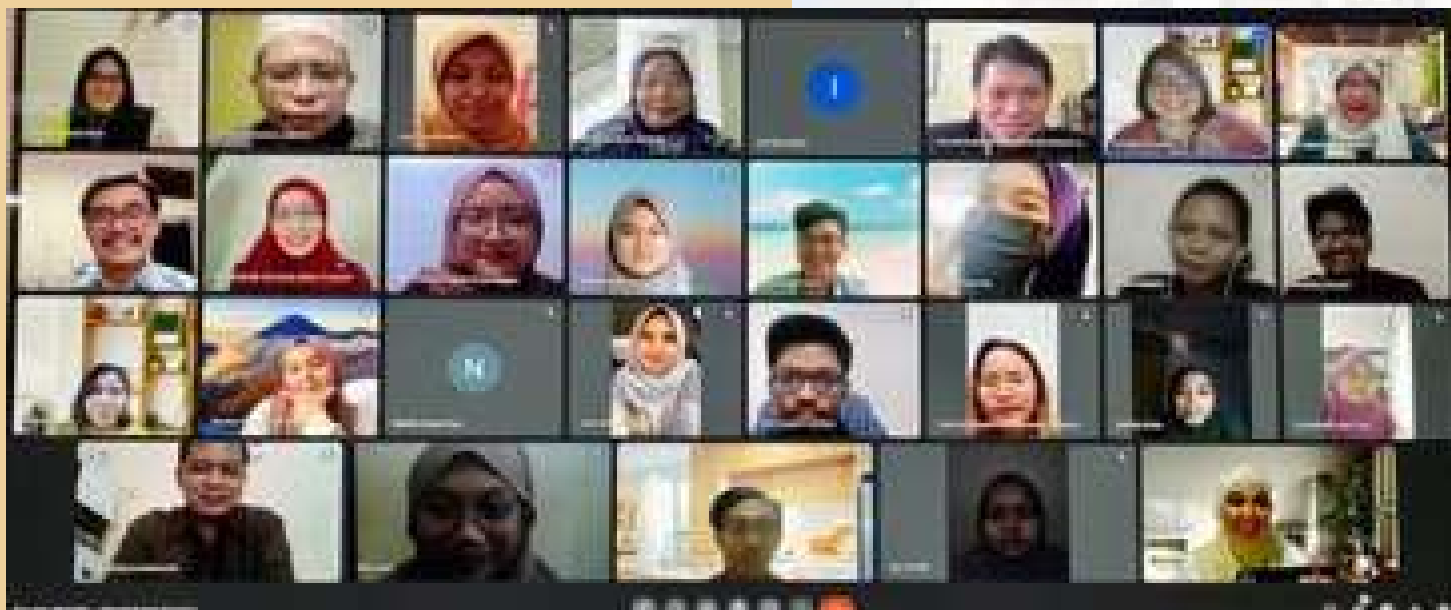

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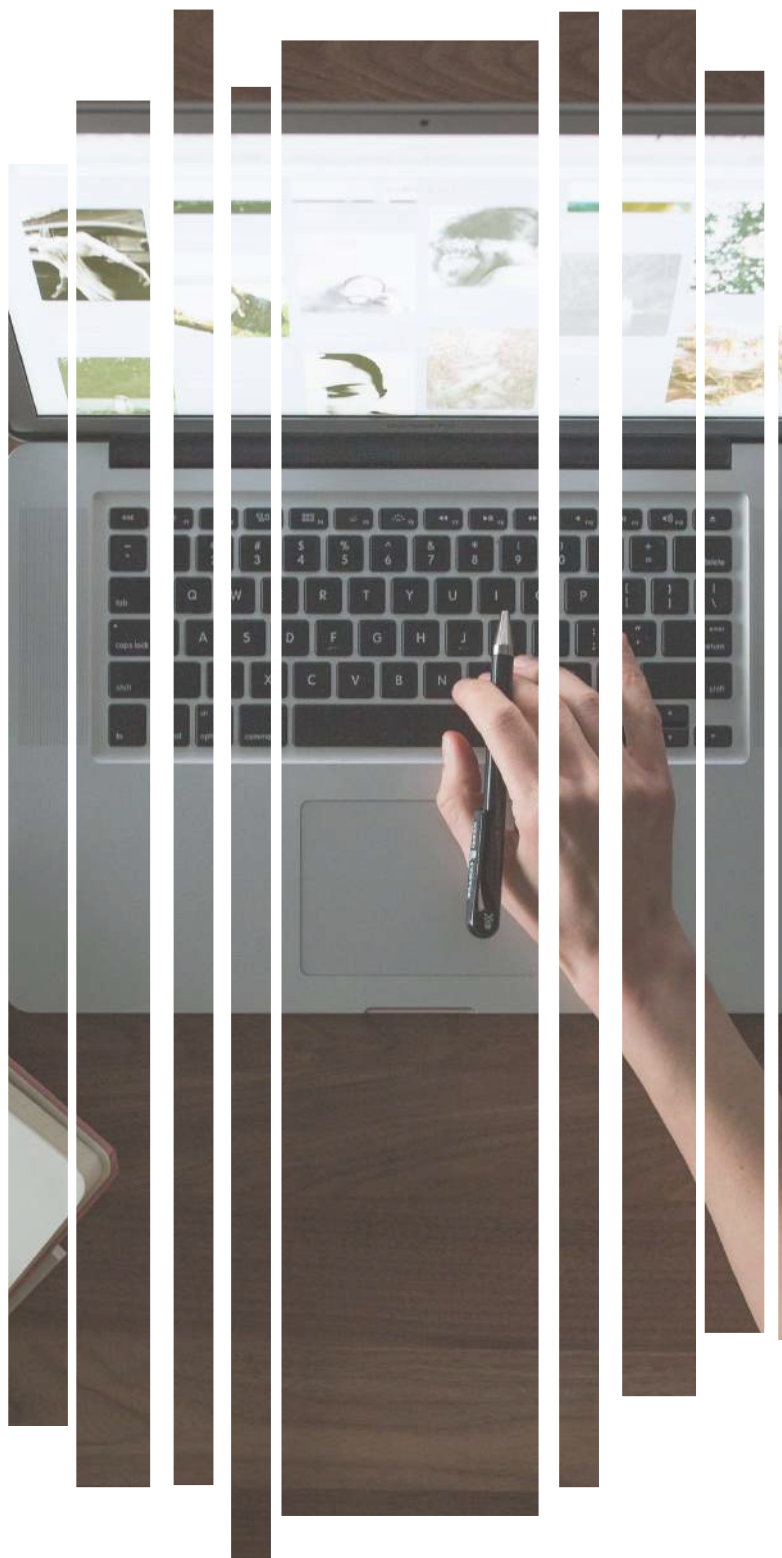
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
